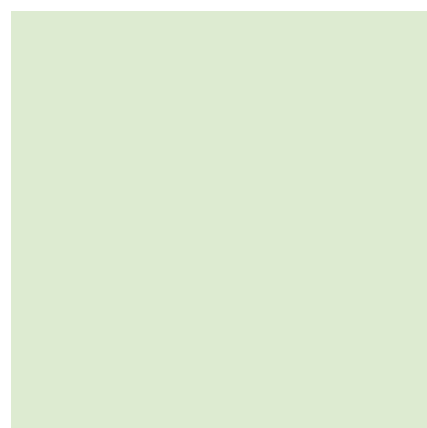




Student safety

Educating students about safety



Our staff are trained in all aspects of student safety and there are many programs undertaken that ensure student safety and educate students about being safe.

Child protection

Strict checks are in place to protect the safety of students including criminal record checks of all permanent and casual teachers. We teach our students to prevent getting into dangerous situations and to recognise when they may be unsafe and how to get help.

Internet safety

All students at our school have access to the internet and web filtering technology prevents students from accessing inappropriate material.

Anti-bullying

We believe that school should be free from bullying and harassment. Our anti-bullying plan outlines strategies for parents, students and teachers to identify, report and deal with bullying behaviour. Any victim or witness of bullying behaviour should report the incident to a teacher or the principal.

Anti-racism

Anti-racism education is taught in our classrooms and we make every effort to ensure our school is free from discrimination. Our anti-racism contact officer can help any member of our school community who wishes to raise a complaint of racism.

Road safety

Road safety education is taught to all students from Kindergarten to Year 10 as part of Personal Development, Health and Physical Education. In high school students are also taught driver safety at school.
