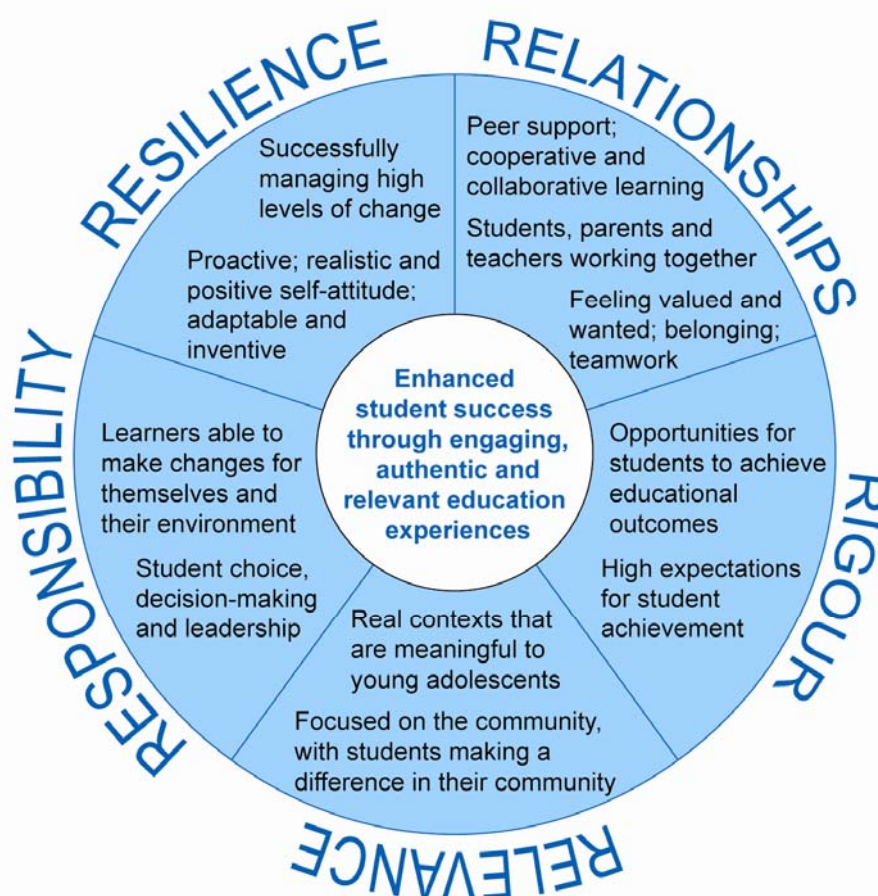


Developing a middle years approach
