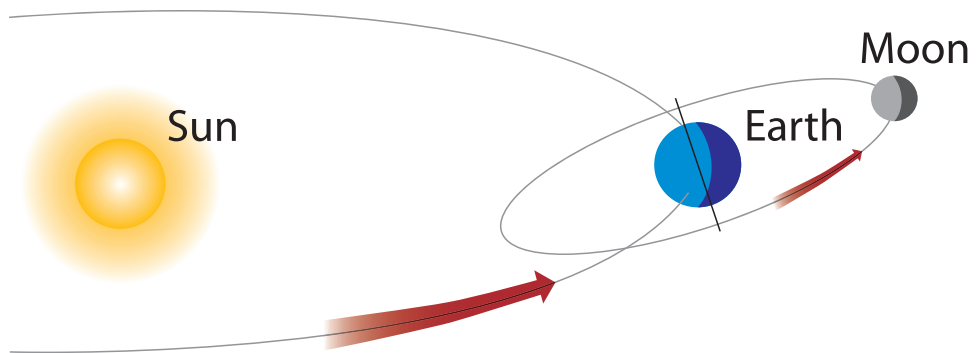
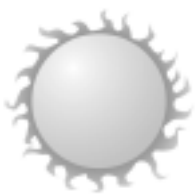


# Sun, Earth and Moon
