Response

Paragraph 1:

Give the title of the group's favorite representation of a fairytale, and give at least two reasons why the group enjoyed the representation.

e.g. the irreverent way that Herb drew a moustache on the Queen, and how Childs mocked the arrogance of nobility.

Paragraph 2:

Refer to any alterations made to the original fairytale character/s. Find the original story so you can compare and appreciate how and why the changes have been made.

e.g. if you chose *Goldilocks and the three bears* you could discuss how the inquisitive and frightened Goldilocks has been transformed into a rude and egocentric child.

Paragraph 3:


Discuss the visual features used to represent the fairytale the group has chosen and the character/s in the story.

- body language: facial expressions, gestures, stance etc.
- colour
- composition
- gaze
- vectors
- rule of thirds


Follow these three steps:
